6. ENTRY & REGISTRATION DEADLINES

Onsite Registration **MUST** be done on the official practice day Monday March 1st during 10:00-16:00 at the onsite tournament office.

Withdrawal or non appearance

- Withdrawal from a tournament must be made by contacting the tournament office.

The following penalty fees apply:

- After closing date for entries - 100€
- Failure to register - 350€
- Failure to appear at the start or breach without valid reason - 350€
